Helpful Hints

Writing school notes

Don't forget if your child is absent from school you will need to write a note within seven days. It must explain why your child missed school and how many days your child was absent. Remember to include the date. If your child is going to be away for more than three days please call the school and let them know.

Clever lunches

If using tomato, slice thinly and place between other fillings to stop the sandwich going soggy. Freeze banana bread and muffins ready for the school lunch box – they're great for a snack.

Reading to children at home

Children learn about the value and importance of reading as they watch their family read and write in everyday life. Here are a few simple things you can do at home to make reading fun.

1. Listen to your child read every day, even if only for a short time.
2. Discuss the meanings of stories and words.
3. Talk about books together and make reading a shared, enjoyable activity.
4. See that there is a range of reading material, both fiction and non-fiction, for your child at home.
5. Try not to let television intrude on reading time – set aside some uninterrupted time to read with your child.
