Student Conduct Code

The final section of our student conduct code is for **inappropriate behaviour**. These guidelines apply to school and any school sanctioned activity e.g camps, discos, excursions, sporting events, etc.

A student whose behaviour is inappropriate is given an 'Orange Slip'. He / she is placed on a half of lunchtime detention and is on a two-week probationary period. If the child receives another Orange Slip in this two-week period they are placed on a 'Red Slip' and receive a two-day lunchtime detention. Parents are informed if children receive an Orange or Red slip, via a standard note, which is to be signed and returned. Parents may be requested to attend an interview.
